Author Name(s)

Write the full given name and surname of all authors. Example: Chukwuemeka Daniel Obi. Do not use initials only.

Affiliations

Write the full name of your department, faculty, university, and country for each author.

ORCID iD

Include your ORCID iD here. Format: 0000-0000-0000-0000. Register free at orcid.org if you do not have one.

Corresponding Author

Indicate which author will handle correspondence. Provide their email address and full postal address.

ABSTRACT

Abstract

Write your abstract here. Maximum 250 words. Your abstract must summarize: (1) the objective of the study, (2) the methods used, (3) the key results, and (4) the significance of your findings. Do not include references in the abstract.

Keywords

List 4 to 6 keywords here, separated by commas. Choose words that best describe your research topic. Example: urban planning, land use, sustainability, Nigeria, GIS, environmental management.

MAIN TEXT STRUCTURE

1. Introduction

Introduce your topic here. State the background to the study, identify the research problem or gap, state your research objectives, and explain the significance of your work.

2. Materials and Methods

Describe how you conducted your research. Include your study area, data sources, research design, tools used, and analysis methods. Be detailed enough for another researcher to replicate your study.

3. Results

Present your findings here. Use tables and figures where appropriate. Label all tables and figures correctly and refer to them within the text near their first mention.

4. Discussion

Interpret your results here. Compare your findings with existing literature. Explain what your results mean and their implications for the field.

5. Conclusion

Summarize the key takeaways from your study. State your recommendations and suggest areas for future research.

Acknowledge funding sources, research assistants, institutions, or individuals who contributed to your work but are not listed as authors.
